

# Kimunu Food Web

## Original Island Biodiversity

As a tropical island Kimunu receives plenty of sunlight often averaging 20,000 kcal per day, which adequately supplies an abundance of Cattail and Island grass. Grasshoppers located on the east part of the island consume both island grass and cattail, but the mice and other rodents only feed on the cattail species. All rodents are preyed upon by skunks and birds but grasshoppers are the birds favorite for on the east side. The common predator of skunks, rodents and birds on this island are the large predatory snakes that roam the island but live mostly on the south side.

## INTRODUCED Species


