

Когда строим вопрос к лицу (Кто?), нужно закрыть лицо и на его место поставить WHO.

При этом нужно помнить, что WHO = HE/SHE/IT:

I work hard.

Jane works hard.

WHO WORKS HARD? – Кто тяжело работает? (это вопрос к обоим предложениям)

Когда строим вопрос к дополнению (Кому? Кого? Кем? Для кого? С кем? и т.д.), нужно строить по всем правилам построения специальных вопросов:

We have been doing the dishes with Patricia for half an hour.

Ask questions about the words **in bold**.

*Jacob is playing with his sister now.*

*Who is playing with their sister now?*

*Jacob is playing with **his sister** now.*

*Who is Jacob playing with now?*

- 9) **Roberta** showed her new baby boy to Neymar the other day.
- 10) Roberta showed her new baby boy **to Neymar** the other day.
- 11) **Mr. Smith and his wife** are going to order a huge TV-set for Bella soon.
- 12) Mr. Smith and his wife are going to order a huge TV-set **for Bella** soon.
- 13) **Peter** has just lent his water heater to Bob.
- 14) Peter has just lent his water heater **to Bob**.
- 15) **Helen** will be painting a picture for Jeremy at 7 p.m. tomorrow.

- 16) Helen will be painting a picture **for Jeremy** at 7 p.m. tomorrow.
- 17) **Josh** can help you.
- 18) Josh can help **you**.
- 19) **Walter** has been making French food for his girlfriend all day.
- 20) Walter has been making French food **for his girlfriend** all day.
