

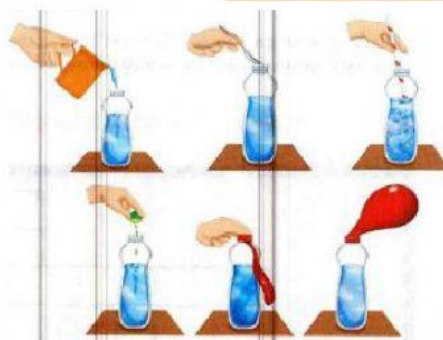

_____ add a few drops of red food coloring to the water in the volcano.
