an + vowel (a, u, i, o, e) an umbrella an egg	<i>Example:</i> He has got an apple. Has he got an apple? He hasn't got an apple.

* some / any + plural nouns / uncountable nouns

some (+)	any (-) (?)
There are some clouds in the sky. There is some milk in the mug.	Have you got any sweets? We haven't got any sweets. Have we got any milk? We haven't got any milk.
