The Australian Adventurer

Australia is an enormous continent. It is about 4,000 kilometers from east to west. But in 1912, one man decided to travel across the continent... by bicycle! The man's name was Francis Birtles. He was born in Melbourne, Australia, in 1881 and he always loved adventure. When he was a young man, he bought a bicycle and started cycling. He rode around Australia twice and became the first person to ride a bike across the continent from west to east.

Francis became very popular and a lot of newspapers wrote stories about him. As a result, in 1926 a car manufacturing company gave him a car and asked him to drive it across Australia. 
