



## ALASKA BAY BOAT WILDLIFE

Welcome to Seward, Alaska, the **best place** for wildlife **watching**. This guide has information about some of the animals in the **area**. Look for them on your boat trip!

**Orcas** are called **killer whales** too. But they aren't whales - they're part of the **dolphin** family. We usually see orcas in family groups, called **pods**. A good time to see orcas is from June to September. They're black and white.

**Sea otters** live in groups. Sometimes there are 100 otters in one **colony**. They're brown or black. **Sea otters** love swimming and they often swim on their **backs**.



**Puffins** usually live on the sea. They've got black, white and grey bodies. Their beaks are black and orange. In May, they come to the coast and make their **nests**. They have one chick. You can see them flying to their nests with lots of fish in their **beaks**.
