


FREQUENCY ADVERBS

Adverbs of Frequency



Examples:

Frequency	Adverbs
100%	always, constantly, continuously, habitually.
90%	usually, normally, mostly, regularly.
75%	frequently, generally, repeatedly.
60%	often
50%	sometimes
40%	occasionally, sporadically.
20%	rarely, seldom, infrequently.
0%	never.
