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PRONOUNS: NOTES

SUBJECTIVE	OBJECTIVE	POSSESSIVE	REFLEXIVE
I	me	my, mine	myself
We	us	our, ours	ourselves
You	you	your, yours	yourself (singular), yourselves (plural)
He	him	his	himself
She	her	her, hers	herself
They	them	their, theirs	Themselves
It	it	its	itself

Examples:

1. I am Siti. This book belongs to me. It's my book. The book is mine. I bought the book myself.
2. We are siblings. This toy belong to us. It's our toy. The toy is ours. We bought the toy ourselves.
3. You are Sarah. This bag belongs to you. It's your bag. The bag is yours. You bought the bag yourself.
4. You are the pupils of 6 Mawar. This class belongs to you. It's your class. The class is yours. You must keep the class clean by yourselves.
5. He is my brother. That is his pen. The pen is his. He bought the pen himself.
6. She is my mother. This is her cake. The cake is hers. She bakes the cake herself.
7. They are my cousins. That is their cat. The cat is theirs. They take care of the cat themselves.
8. This is a cat. It is a black cat. Those are its kittens. It takes care of its kittens itself.

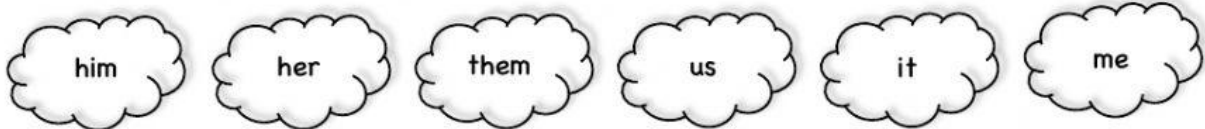

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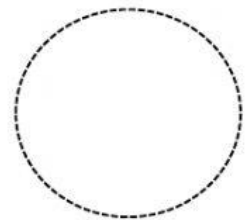
