



Sarah Ann Gill

Sarah Ann Gill was a church leader in Barbados during the days of slavery. She was born in 1795. Her mother was black, and her father was white. She was a member and a leader in the Me-tho-dist church in Barbados. Many black people and coloured persons went to the Me-tho-dist church. However, many white, rich people did not like the Me-tho-dist church, and they became very hostile towards it.

Because so many persons did not like the Me-tho-dist church, they chased the leaders of the church out of Barbados. Some persons even burned the church. However, Sarah Ann Gill opened a church in her house and kept church services there. Because of this, persons wanted to burn her house down as well, threatened her life and prosecuted her for keeping church.

Sarah Ann Gill died on February 25, 1866. A church in Black Rock is named after her. She was made a national hero of Barbados in 1998. She is one of two female national heroes.
