

Sarah Ann Gill

Sarah Ann Gill was a church leader in Barbados during the days of slavery. She was born in 1795. Her mother was black, and her father was white. She was a member and a leader in the Me-tho-dist church in Barbados. Many black people and coloured persons went to the Me-tho-dist church. However, many white, rich people did not like the Me-tho-dist church, and they became very hostile towards it.

Because so many persons did not like the Me-tho-dist church, they chased the leaders of the church out of Barbados. Some persons even burned the church. However, Sarah Ann Gill opened a church in her house and kept church services there. Because of this, persons wanted to burn her house down as well, threatened her life and <u>prosecuted</u> her for keeping church.

Sarah Ann Gill died on February 25, 1866. A church in Black Rock is named after her. She was made a national hero of Barbados in 1998. She is one of two female national heroes.
