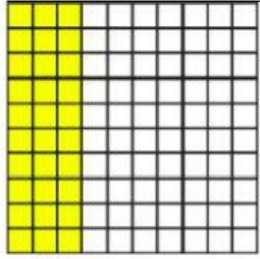
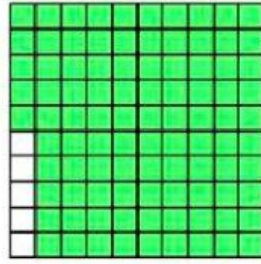


Converting Fractions to Percentage



$$\frac{30}{100} = 30\%$$



$$\frac{95}{100} = 95\%$$
