Present continuous with future meaning

We form the present continuous like this:

Affirmative

I'm walking
we / you / they're walking
he / she / it's walking

Negative

I'm not walking
we / you / they aren't walking
he / she / it isn't walking

Questions

Am I walking?
Are we / you / they walking?
Is he / she / it walking?

Heidi's *wearing* a red dress.
We're *having* lunch.

I'm *not thinking* about it this week.
It *isn't raining* at the moment.

Is Sam *coming*?
Where *are you going*?

Present continuous verbs change like this:

Most verbs

+ -ing

sing → *singing*
look → *looking*

Verbs ending -e

remove -e, + -ing

write → *writing*
smile → *smiling*

Verbs ending vowel + consonant

double the final consonant, + -ing

sit → *sitting*
put → *putting*

We use the present continuous to talk about future plans and arrangements with other people.

I'm *having* lunch at school tomorrow.
Jack's *playing* tennis with Ed on Friday.

We use these time expressions with the present continuous for future arrangements:
tomorrow, next Friday, on Tuesday, this evening
