#### Exercise 1: Read and do the tasks. (2.5 ps)

A blizzard is a powerful snowstorm. Low temperatures, strong winds, and large amounts of snow together create this dangerous weather condition. During a blizzard, the driving snow can make it difficult to see far.



During a blizzard the wind blows at speeds of more than 35 miles (56 kilometers) per hour for at least three hours. Visibility (the distance you can see) drops to 0.25 mile (0.4 kilometer) or less. When the weather conditions are bad, main roads and railways may have to be closed, and power and telecommunications lines may stop working.

Blizzards often occur in cold places where winds blow strongly—in Antarctica, for example. However, these storms can happen almost anywhere in the right conditions.
