

Differentiate between the different types of interviews: -

- _____ an employment talks to multiple candidates at the same time. These interviews are normally longer than individual interviews.
- _____ an employment talks to one candidate. These interviews generally last between 20 and 45 minutes.
- _____ an employer asks a candidate to complete the task. It allows the employer to assess the candidate's ability under pressure.
- _____ an employer calls the candidates and ask questions. These are more cost effective. Employers can easily interview people from different locations.
