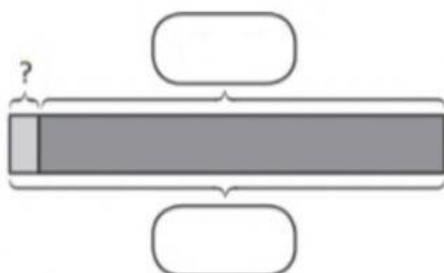


6. Safiah served 5 boxes of strawberries at a party. Each box contained a dozen (1 dozen = 12) strawberries. She gave each of her 7 guests 8 strawberries. How many strawberries did Safiah have left?



Method
1

$$\underline{\quad\quad} \bigcirc \underline{\quad\quad} = \underline{\quad\quad}$$
