## **Superlatives**

How do we form superlative statements? Study and complete the rules for the superlative form in the **grammar reference chart** below.

Adjectives with one syllable: add 'the' + '-est' or '-st'		
cold	the coldest	January is often <u>cold</u> winter month.
nice	the nicest	She is nice person I know.
Adjectives that end in '-y': add 'the' + change '-y' to '-i' then add '-est'		
early	the earliest	He was <u>earl</u> person to arrive.
happy	the happiest	It was happ time of my life.
Adjectives with one syllable that end in CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant): double the last letter, add 'the' + '-est' (never double: w, x, y)		
big	The second secon	Russia is big country in the world.
hot		August is usually hot month of the year.
1101	ille flottesi	August is usually not morning in the year.
Adjectives with two or more syllables: add 'the' + 'most'		
boring	the most boring	It'sboring movie playing right now.
expensive	the most expensive	We ate at expensive restaurant in
		town.
Adjectives that are irregular:		
good	the best	She is student in our class.
bad	the worst	It was storm in many years.
far	the farthest/furthest	He lives from my home.
