Suffix is a letter or group of letters that is added to the end of a word to change its meaning or form a different word.

Suffixes	Meaning	Examples
-al, -an, -ar	Of the kind or pertaining to	Classical, Bahamian. molecular
-ant, -ent	State or quality	Important, incompetent
-en, -et, -kin, -ling, -ock	Small, little or connected with	Pathogen, intranet
-eous, -ous	Resembling or having the nature of	Spontaneous, malicious
-ess, -ress	Having the feminine form	Janitress, seamstress
