Each player starts with their own paper and pen or pencil to draw with. Without the other players seeing, each player first draws a monster's head at the top of the page, then they fold the paper so that you can't see the head and pass the paper to the person on their right. Next, each player draws the monster's body, arms, wings or whatever they want. When done, fold the paper and pass the paper to the right, and this time you draw the last part like legs, feet. Then fold the paper so it's all covered. Pass the papers around again for each player to open up to show what they have drawn.
