More on Adjectives

ADJECTIVE of QUANTITY

- Tells the amount or estimated amount of the noun or pronoun in the sentence.
- It does not provide information about exact numbers, it tells only the amount of noun in relative or whole.

Read the sentences below.



There is **much** water in the jug.

Much describes the amount of water in the jug but it does not tell the exact number.



There are **hundred** soldiers joining the fun run.

Hundred describes the number of soldiers doing fun run but not the specific number.



Queen Victoria had played alone for her

whole childhood.

Whole describes Queen Victoria's number of playing alone during childhood but the exact number is not told.
