HAVE/HAS to describe people:

HE **has** = el tiene
She **has** = ella tiene
it **has** = eso/a tiene

POSITIVE

I **have** = yo tengo
you **have** = tu/ustedes tienen
we **have** = nosotros tenemos
they **have** = ellos tienen

HE **doesn't have** = el no tiene
She **doesn't have** = ella no tiene
it **doesn't have** = eso/a no tiene

NEGATIVE

I **don't have** = yo no tengo
you **don't have** = tu/ustedes no tienen
we **don't have** = nosotros no tenemos
they **don't have** = ellos no tienen

INTERROGATIVE

Does he **have** = ¿el tiene?
Does she **have** = ¿ella tiene?
Does it **have** = ¿eso/a tiene?

Do I **have**? = ¿yo tengo?
Do you **have**? = ¿tu/ustedes tienen?
Do we **have**? = ¿nosotros tenemos?
Do they **have**? = ¿ellos tienen?

EXAMPLES:

I **have** curly hair = Yo tengo cabello rizado
She **has** blue eyes = Ella tiene ojos azules
¿Do you have long hair? NO I, don't /Yes, I do
