binge watch (verb, slang) watch a TV programme or series on one device while using another at the same time, e.g. to tweet about the programme or check information

channel (noun) a television station

catch-up (verb, idiom) watch several episodes of a TV series one after the other

device (noun) a method of sending or receiving data over a computer network

device (noun) a piece of equipment that has been designed to do a particular job

contestant (noun) a person who takes part in a game, quiz, or competition

two-screen (noun) a service that allows you to watch television programmes after the time when they were originally broadcast
