

# BASKETBALL RULES

*Do you know basketball rules? Put the verbs into the Present Simple Active or the Present Simple Passive and find out.*

Basketball \_\_\_\_\_ (play) with a round, orange ball that \_\_\_\_\_ (bounce). It \_\_\_\_\_ (play) between two teams of five players. They \_\_\_\_\_ (try) to score by tossing the ball through \_\_\_\_\_ the opponent's \_\_\_\_\_ basket. Teams \_\_\_\_\_ (allow) to have a coach, a manager, a doctor and an interpreter. A game of basketball \_\_\_\_\_ (make up) of four quarters. Each quarter \_\_\_\_\_ (last) ten minutes. At the start of every game the referee \_\_\_\_\_ (throw) the basketball up in the air, and one player from each team \_\_\_\_\_ (try) to hit it to their teammates, that \_\_\_\_\_ (call) a "jump ball". After four quarters, the team who \_\_\_\_\_ (score) the most points \_\_\_\_\_ (win). If the two teams \_\_\_\_\_ (score) the same number of points, there \_\_\_\_\_ (be) a five-minute "overtime" to see who can score more points. "Overtime" \_\_\_\_\_ (play) over and over until one team finally \_\_\_\_\_ (score) more points.
