Prefer/ Would Rather

PREFER

We use 'prefer-ing' to say what we prefer in general

- **Prefer + Noun**
I prefer tea.
- **Prefer + Noun TO Noun**
Maggie prefers pizza to hamburger.
- **Prefer + Ving TO Ving.**
Layla prefers swimming to jogging in the park.

WOULD RATHER

We use 'would rather' to say what we want in a particular situation (not in general)

- **Would rather + Verb THAN Verb**
Layla would rather swim than jog in the park.
