

**ADJECTIVES** are describing words. They tell about a noun or pronoun.

**Adjectives Tell:**

**WHAT KIND:** *sharp · furry · freckled · cruel · plastic · ragged*  
*The cat had sharp claws.*  
*We take plastic spoons on our picnic.*

**WHICH ONE(S):** *this · that · these · those*  
*That truck is new.*  
*These mittens are soft.*

**HOW MANY:** *six · eight · few · many · several · hundred*  
*Several boys were in line.*  
*John read eight books during the summer.*

**Articles:**

**ARTICLES** are a special type of adjective.  
*a · an · the*  
*Hand me the paper.*  
*Please give me a book.*

**Comparing:**

**ADJECTIVES** can compare nouns and pronouns to each other.  
*taller · steepest · best · worst · earlier*  
*She is taller than you.*  
*We walked up the steepest hill.*
