

Prefixes (re-)

Rule:

A prefix is a word part added to the beginning of a word. A prefix changes the meaning of the base word.

The prefix re- means again. For example: retie = to tie again

Write the new word with a prefix that would match the meaning.

	Base word	New word	Meaning
1	play		To play again
2	match		To match again
3	heat		To heat again
4	view		To view again

Look at each word. Write its base word (*the word without the prefix*).
