What	do	you	have for breakfast?	Coffee and toast.
When	do	they	have breakfast?	At 8:00.
Where	do	they	have breakfast?	In a cafe.
Who	do	you	have breakfast with?	Our children.
How	do	they	go to work?	By bus.

- Simple present +, -, and ? is the same for *I, you, we, you (plural), and they*.

- Simple present *Wh-* questions ask for information. They don't take *yes* or *no* answers.

- Common question words are *who, what, where, when, why, and how*.



Word order in questions

+ You have breakfast.
yes / no ? **Do** you have breakfast?
Wh- ? **Where** do you have breakfast?
