

Present Simple

Positive, Negative, Interrogative



FORM

POSITIVE

I, you, we, they + infinitive
He, she, it + infinitive + -s
Examples:
I drink milk every day.
He dinks milk every day.

NEGATIVE

I, you, we, they + **don't** + infinitive
He, she, it + **doesn't** + infinitive.
Examples:
I don't drink milk every day.
He doesn't drink milk every day.

INTERROGATIVE

Do + I/you/we/they + infinitive
Does + he/she/it + infinitive
Examples:
Do I drink milk every day?
Does he drink milk every day?

3rd PERSON SINGULAR SPELLING RULES:

1. General Rule:

ADD -S

Examples:
Walk - walks
talk - talks
answer - answers

2. Verbs ending in S, Ss, Ch, Sh, X:

ADD -ES

Examples:
miss - misses
watch - watches
wash - washes
fix - fixes

3. Verbs ending in -O:

ADD -ES

Examples:
go - goes
do - does

4. Verbs ending in Consonant + Y:

CHANGE Y INTO I AND
ADD -ES

Examples:
study - studies
tidy - tidies

5. Verbs ending in Vowel + Y:

ADD -S

Examples:
play - plays
enjoy - enjoys
stay - stays
