SEA EGGS

The sea egg is a local delicacy which many of us enjoy. The white sea egg is one of the seventeen species of sea urchin which may be found in the coastal waters of Barbados.

5 Its spined shell contains the golden roes and once you have tried it, chances are you will love it.

Found in relatively shallow waters at a depth of about six metres along the south coast of the island, the sea eggs are picked from the sea floor by divers carrying a pole and basket.

10 Back on shore they break the shells, remove and wash the roes. The roes are then packed into unbroken shells and a grape leaf, also full of the golden meat is placed on top.

This very nutritious delicacy is prepared by steaming while still in the shell or seasoned and fried to be served with a plate of rice.
