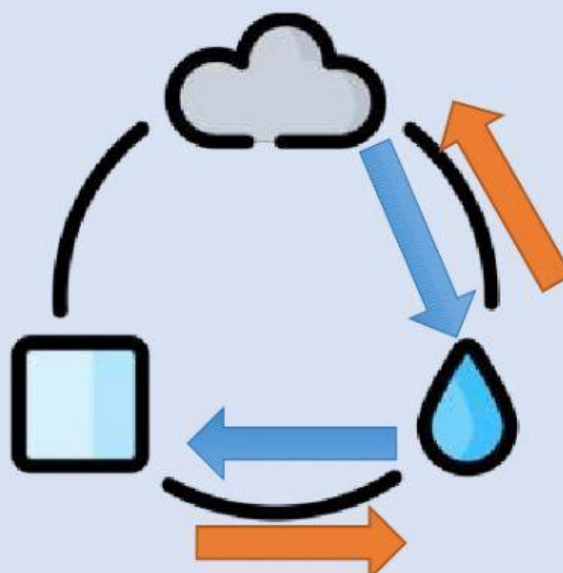

Yuhu! We can make a snowman!

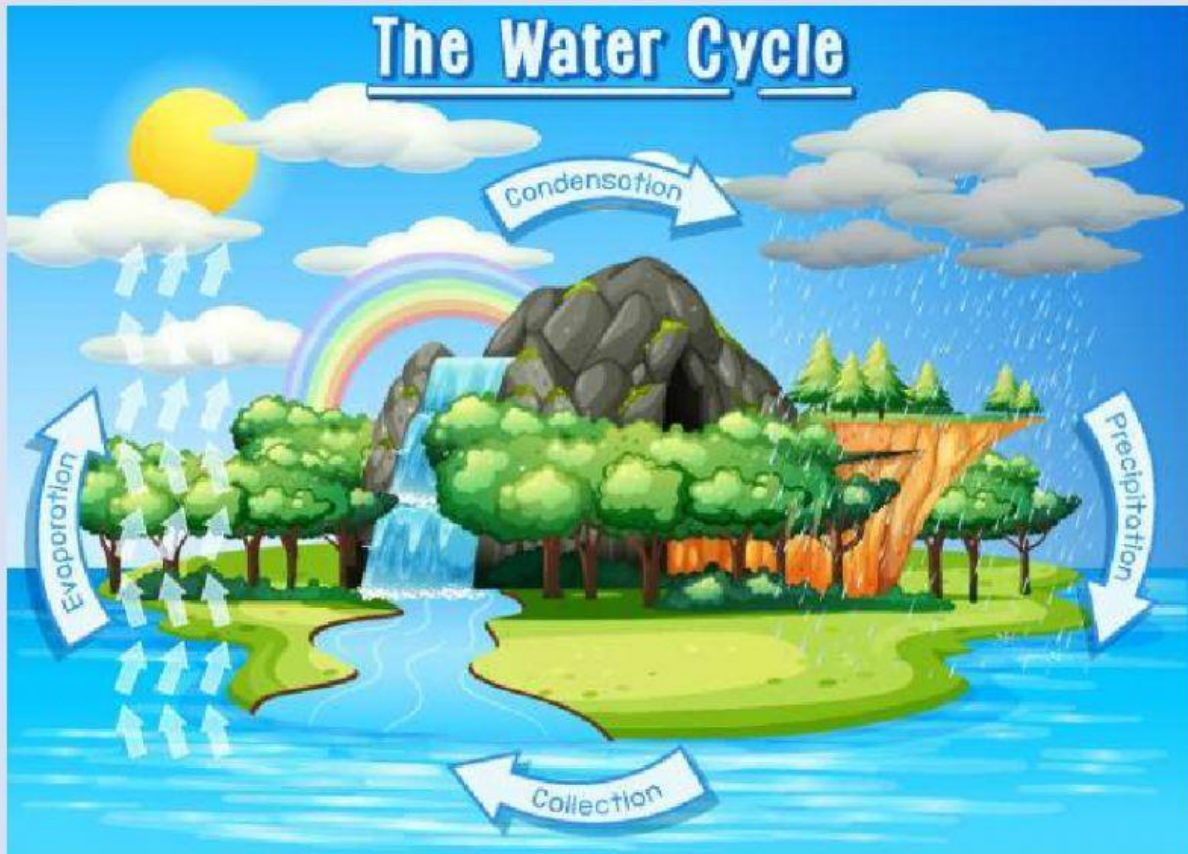


The ice cream is delicious and very cold, it is If we put it under the sun it will get hot and it will, the ice cream will be Oh! That's a pity!
