

A Visit to Long Island

Long Island is west of Rum Cay and East of Exuma. It is located 265 km south-east of Nassau. It is approximately 92km long and 6½ km wide at its widest point. The **Tropic of Cancer** passes through the northern tip of the island.

There are six settlements on the island. The main settlements are **Deadman's Cay, Stella Maris, and Clearance Town**.

Clearance Town is the capital. You can also find the twin churches of St Peter and St Paul built by **Father Jerome**. St Peter is the Catholic Church, and St Paul is the Anglican.

Many **citrus** fruits like oranges and fruits such as bananas grow here. The people of Long Island raise **sheep and goats**. These fruits and cattle are shipped to **Nassau** to be sold. The **silver top plant** also grows on the island. These plants are used in the making of **baskets and mats**. There used to be a **shrimp farm** on the island.

Long Island was called **Yama** by the Lucayans. Lucayan artifacts like the **duhos** have been found in **Cartwright's caves** on the island. The island is also believed to be Christopher Columbus' third stop during his first voyage to the New World. There is also the famous **Dean's Blue Hole**. It has the world's deepest underwater sinkhole at 200m deep. It is located in a bay west of Clarence Town.



The settlement of Salt Pond is home to **Long Island Regatta**. It is held every year on **Whit Monday**. The settlement of Deadman's Cay got its name from a cay just off the coast of the settlement which was used to bury the dead.
