Lisa, Nina, Julie and Tasha first met when they were classmates in 2012. Their interest in singing and dancing gave them the idea to form a girl group called the Sugar Girls in 2014. In 2015, they won Teenage Voice, a local singing contest and were offered a recording contract with RTV Entertainment. However, the girls decided to choose Sunshine Recording.

You can get up close to beautiful marine life. Most snorkelers swim at the surface. They use the snorkel to breath and look down to gaze at the ocean floor.

Snorkeling is a better option than diving. You only need a mask, a snorkel, a pair of fins and a swim vest. Some swimmers opt out of using a swim vest as it can hinder movement in the water. So, if you're wearing a tank on your back and breathing through a mouthpiece connected to that tank, you're scuba diving. You'll also usually wear some sort of exposure protection, such as a rash-guard in the tropics, a wetsuit in temperate climes, or a dry suit in cold water.

More advanced snorkelers who have good breath-holding capacity can try skin diving.

In skin diving, snorkelers will occasionally dive below the surface, while holding their breath, and come up to the surface for air. The reward for this way of snorkeling is a much closer view of aquatic life and not just view from the surface.

Discovering the underwater world is truly an incredible experience and completely different from earth as you know it. Being able to take part in this world, to see the fish in their natural habitat is an experience you will never forget. The moment you swim among the marine life and let them inspect and accept you, is truly amazing. With these fun beach activities to do, you'll never be bored at the shore again!
