Have to is very similar to **must**. We use it to talk about things that are necessary.
 You **have to** do it. = It's necessary. It's the rule.

Affirmative	Questions	Short answers
have/has to + base form	do/does + subject + have to + base form	yes/no + do/does
I/you/we/they have to go to school.	Do I/you/we/they have to go to school?	Yes, I/you/we/they do .
He/she/it has to go to school.	Does he/she/it have to go to school?	No, I/you/we/they don't .
	Why do I have to go to bed?	Yes, he/she/it does .
	When does Jo have to go home?	No, he/she/it doesn't .

The negative form of **have to** has a different meaning from **mustn't**.
 You **don't have to** do it. = It isn't necessary.
