Have to is very similar to **must**. We use it to talk about things that are necessary.
 You **have to do it.** = It's necessary. It's the rule.

Affirmative	Questions	Short answers
have/has to + base form I/you/we/they have to go to school. He/she/it has to go to school.	do/does + subject + have to + base form Do I/you/we/they have to go to school? Does he/she/it have to go to school? Why do I have to go to bed? When does Jo have to go home?	yes/no + do/does Yes, I/you/we/they do . No, I/you/we/they don't . Yes, he/she/it does . No, he/she/it doesn't .

The negative form of **have to** has a different meaning from **mustn't**.
 You **don't have to do it.** = It isn't necessary.
