

REPORTED SPEECH

DIRECT SPEECH

"I love Rachel", Ross says.

REPORTED SPEECH

Ross says that he loves Rachel.

Reporting verbs: say, tell, ask, answer, yell, whisper, etc..



If your reporting verb is in the past form, you have to change the tense in the reported sentence. You also change time expressions and pronouns.

DIRECT SPEECH

today

now

yesterday

tommorow

tonight

REPORTED SPEECH

that day

then

the day before

the next/following day

that night

DIRECT SPEECH

last (week)

ago

next (week)

here

this

these

REPORTED SPEECH

the week before

before

the following (week)

there

that

those

TENSE CHANGES

PRESENT SIMPLE

"I use this study app every day", Frank said.



PAST SIMPLE

Frank said that he used that study app every day.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

"We are eating pizza and watching a movie", Mary and Melody said.



PAST CONTINUOUS

Mary and Melody said that they were eating pizza and watching a movie.

PAST SIMPLE

"I bought a new laptop yesterday", Jerry said.



PAST PERFECT

Jerry said that he had bought a new laptop the day before.

FUTURE SIMPLE

"I will buy 2 tickets to a new play", Harry said.



WOULD

Harry said he would buy 2 tickets to a new play the next day.
