VOCABULARY: A TYPICAL SCHOOL DAY IN UK

- A piece of land, at school or in a public area, where children can play.
- (in Britain) A person who stops traffic by holding up a circular sign on a pole to allow children to cross a road safely .
- A gathering of all the teachers and pupils at the beginning of the school day.
- The set of clothes that, in some schools, it is compulsory for schoolchildren to wear .
- Move to the other side of the road.
- A place in a factory, shop, or school where meals are served to the people who work or study there.
- A period of rest or recreation, esp at school .
