WORD	DEFINITION

3. DRUG-	AN ADDICTIVE DRUG FOUND IN TOBACCO.
4. VAPING-	A DRUG USED TO PREVENT ILLNESSES AND DISEASES.
5. PASSIVE SMOKING	COMES FROM CIGARETTES, PIPES, CIGARS AND SHISHA PIPES (HOOKAH)
6. ADDICTION-	THE BODY'S NEED FOR A LARGER AND LARGER DOSES OF A DRUG TO PRODUCE THE SAME EFFECT.
7. SECOND-HAND TOBACCO SMOKING	A CHRONIC, RELAPSING BRAIN DISEASE THAT IS CAUSED BY COMPULSIVE DRUG SEEKING AND USE.
8. NICOTINE	A SUBSTANCE OTHER THAN FOOD THAT CHANGES THE STRUCTURE OR FUNCTION OF THE BODY OR MIND.
9. TOLERANCE	BREATHING IN OTHER PEOPLE'S TOBACCO SMOKE
10. MEDICINE	THE ADDICTIVE CHEMICAL FOUND IN CANNABIS.
