COMPARATIVES + SUPERLATIVES (LONG ADJECTIVES)

a. Comparative of Long Adjectives

We use **be** + **comparative adjective** + **than** to compare two things.

S1 + to be + more + long adj + than + S2

b. Superlative of Long Adjectives

We use **superlative** adjectives to compare three or more things and say that one of them is 'number one'.

=> S + tobe + **the most** + **long adj** ...
