Subject + verb to be + verb -ing + complement
I + am + studying + English
You + are + playing + videogames

NEGATIVE

Subject + verb to be NEG + verb -ing + complement
He + isn't + studying + for the exam
We + aren't + running + in the park

INTERROGATIVE

Verb to be + subject + verb -ing + complement + ?
Are + they + cooking + pasta + ?
Is + she + watching + TV + ?
