It is used to make a **suggestion requesting permission or agreement**. It is usually used in question form rather than in a statement.

Shall we design some props?

Shall I open the window?

making suggestions

COULD

shows the suggestion as being **an option**.

We **could** we use blue paper
We **could** buy Laura a ring

It is usually used in **question form** and in **affirmative** sentences.

LET'S !

It is used to make a **suggest for a group including the speaker**
