
2 Mr Lim bought 9 boxes of oranges. Each box contains 24 oranges. What is the total number of oranges Mr Lim has?


3 A town library has 570 story books and dictionaries. If the number of dictionaries is 250 less than story books, calculate the number of story books the library has.
