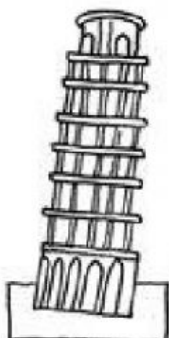

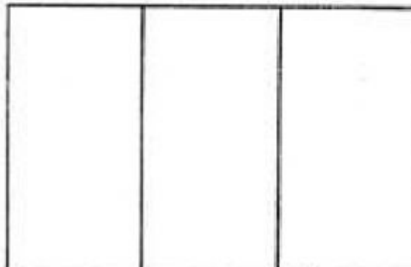


The ancient Romans were skillful engineers that built many surviving structures such as the Coliseum, which dates from A.D. 80 and once hosted gladiator battles.
