I Read about the illnesses below.



If someone **sneezes** or **coughs** on us, their germs can give us a **cold**. This makes our **nose run**. We may get a **sore throat**. We may have a **headache**. We should put our hand or tissue in front of our mouth and nose when we cough or sneeze.

Some illnesses can cause a **rash – red spots**. This is called **chickenpox**. They can be **itchy**. We should try not to scratch them. We also feel **hot**.



If we eat food with unclean hands, we could get **stomach flu**. Your **tummy** might **ache**, feel **sick** or **go to the toilet a lot**. Unclean hands have germs on them. We should wash our hands before eating or cooking to avoid this.

Sometimes young children can get sores inside their mouth (**ulcers**). **Itchy rashes** can also be seen **on their hands and feet**. We call this **hand, mouth, foot disease (HMFD)**. To avoid this, it is important to wash your hands with soap, clean surfaces you touch and not share drinking cup drinks and eating utensils.
