


✓ Day 3

 **Content/Big Ideas:** Putting together numbers 0-5  
(Addition)



 **Explain:** When we put things together, it is called addition. Count how many objects are shown below.



The answer is called **sum**. The addition of small numbers can be done using your fingers too.

**Examples:**

 5	+	 2	= 7
 2	+	 2	= 4
 4	+	 0	= 4

Use your fingers to add numbers. Follow the illustration above and count how many numbers are there in all.

 **Concept-Based Assessment:** Count the objects, write the numbers and find the sum (1-5).




