

# FISHING BATS

I live in Santiago de Cuba, in the Caribbean. There are a lot of really cool bats in this region.

My favorite is the "fishing bat" - we call it the *murciélago pescador*.



Their bodies are only 10-12 cm long, but their wings are a meter wide! They have very long legs and they are about 75 g. The male bats have orange bodies and the female ones have gray bodies. They live in caves near the beach and they only come out at night. They fly fast and they can swim! They eat insects and they also eat small fish. They catch fish in the ocean with their long legs. They can catch 30 to 40 fish every night!
