

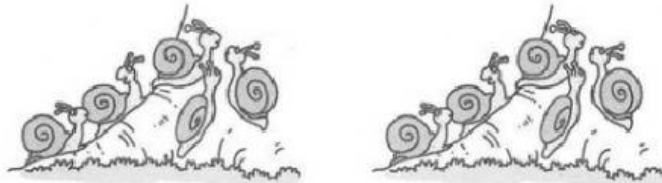
Division

How to divide



Find the number of objects in each group.

(a) Divide 10 snails equally into 2 groups.



$$10 \div \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

There are snails in each group.

Arrange 15 books equally into 3 stacks.



$$15 \div \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

There are books in each stack.

Divide 15 by 5.



$$15 \div \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

There are eggs in each nest.



Division

How to divide



Find the number of groups.

(a) Divide 12 beads into groups of 4.



$$12 \div \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

There are groups of 4 beads.

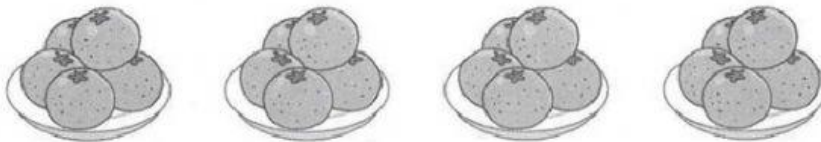
(b) Divide 14 ice cream cones into groups of 7.



$$14 \div \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

There are groups of 7 ice cream cones.

(c) Divide 20 by 5.



$$20 \div \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

There are groups of 5 oranges.
