I	have	not	→ I've not	I	haven't
you	have	not	→ you've not	you	haven't
he	has	not	→ he's not	he	hasn't
she	has	not	→ she's not	she	hasn't
it	has	not	→ it's not	it	hasn't
we	have	not	→ we've not	we	haven't
you	have	not	→ you've not	you	haven't
they	have	not	→ they've not	they	haven't
