**Definitions:**

- A statement put forth as true; in an argument, a statement of position on an issue.
- A judgment based on a personal point of view.
- An overstatement or stretching of the truth.
- A general statement that offers support for a claim.
- Facts, statistics, examples, and other information used to support reasons.

**Illustrations:**

- Bias:** Examples of Confirmation Bias (4 icons: a brain, a magnifying glass, a person writing, a person pointing)
- Claim:** Claim Support Question (Activity sheet with instructions and icons)
- Evidence:** Chalkboard with the question "Can you prove it?"
- Exaggeration:** A man in overalls and a hat is shouting and gesturing dramatically to a group of people.
- Reason:** Two children, Joey and Jill, standing next to a sign that says "I believe... because..."
