ANIMAL: ERMINE

HABITAT: Marshes and rocky areas near woodlands and treeless plains

The ermine doesn't turn completely white in winter—it sports a black tip on its tail year-round. Why? The black blotch is a sneaky defense against flying predators like hawks. When the bird swoops down to attack, the black tip confuses them.

The hawk sees the ermine moving one way, and its tail flailing behind it in other directions. This blur of motion can cause a hawk to miss the ermine entirely.
