


Sherlock Holmes (2009 film)

Sherlock Holmes is a 2009 period mystery _____ film based on the character of the same name created by _____. The film was directed by _____. Robert Downey Jr. portray Sherlock Holmes and _____ plays Dr. John Watson.

Three months later, Watson is engaged to Mary Morstan and moving out of _____; while he enjoys their adventures together, Watson looks forward to not having to deal with Holmes' eccentricities. Meanwhile, Blackwood, who claims to have _____ powers, has been sentenced to death and requests to see Holmes, warning him of _____ more unstoppable deaths that will cause great changes to the world. Blackwood is subsequently hanged.

Holmes is visited by Irene Adler, a former _____ who asks him to find a missing man named Luke Reordan. After her departure, Holmes follows her as she meets with her secret employer, and only learns that the man is a _____ and that he intimidates Adler. Meanwhile, sightings of a living Blackwood and the discovery of his empty tomb convince the _____ that Blackwood has risen from his grave. Reordan is found dead inside Blackwood's coffin. Following a series of _____ from the body, Holmes and Watson find Reordan's hideout and discover experiments attempting to merge science with _____. After they survive a battle with Blackwood's men when they try to torch the lab, Holmes is taken to the Temple of the Four Orders, a secret magical fraternity with considerable political _____. The leaders ask Holmes to stop Blackwood, a former member of the society and Sir Thomas's secret illegitimate _____.

That night, Sir Thomas drowns in his _____ as Blackwood watches, and the next night Lord Coward calls a meeting of the Order. He nominates Blackwood to take command in place of Sir Thomas and Blackwood reveals himself to the group, explaining his intention to seize control of the British Empire and reconquer _____.
