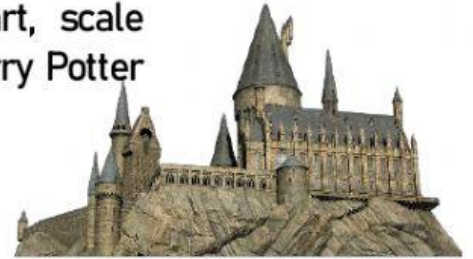




THE MAKING OF HARRY POTTER

Thing to know before visiting:

Taking Photo

- The taking of photographs and capturing video footage with handheld cameras and mobile devices is allowed in all areas of the Studio Tour, apart from the pre-show cinema and green screen areas. Please note, filming with the use of tripods and other specialists' photographic equipment is not permitted.

Face Coverings

- All visitors, aged 11 and up, are required to wear a face covering during their visit, unless exempt. Visitors aged eight and up are encouraged to wear a face covering.



Payments

- Cashless payments are encouraged where possible, if you wish to pay by cash an alternative solution will be available.
